

ANNUAL MOORING SERVICE 2007-2008

It is time to think about winterizing your mooring to keep the tackle safe over the long winter months and maximize the life of the mooring components.

Fall 2007

We will remove your buoy and top tackle and place a winter spar on the mooring. The buoy and top tackle will be safely stored at our shop over the winter. You will receive a bill in the fall for the full mooring service. There will be a note on the bill if there are concerns about your top tackle that was removed. Repairs made before the buoy is re-installed in the spring could result in cost savings for you.

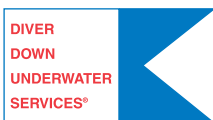
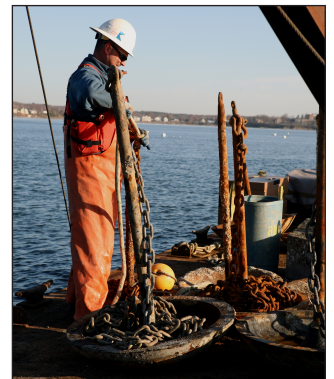
Spring 2008

Your buoy number and blue stripe will be painted as needed. The buoy and top tackle will be re-installed. Inspections will be performed on the mooring system and you will be notified if any repairs are needed.

We furnish Mooring Inspection Certificates for moorings that pass inspection directly to the towns which require them. This ensures you will be in compliance with mooring regulations in your harbor.
